

Project launched to formulate AI governance

The Digital Policy Forum Japan (DPFJ, Chairman: Yasuhiko TANIWAKI) has published a statement, "Towards an AI Governance Framework (ver.1.0)" to provide a direction for discussions on AI-related legislation in Japan and AI governance, which has been expanding globally, keeping in mind recent developments in the area of generative AI.

This statement lays out 10 items to be considered for AI governance under the three pillars of 1) minimizing AI risks, 2) improving convenience, and 3) fostering a healthy market.

Based on this statement, DPFJ will continue to hear from experts from the three perspectives of AI technology, policy and utilization, and will continue to update the statement and hold open forums to broaden scope and deepen discussions toward the establishment of AI governance, and the final document will be compiled by the end of this year.
